NOTICE

Further to our notice dated 01.01.2016 released on the authorised IBPS website, , provisional allotment exercise from the reserve list under CWE RRB-IV has been done based on the post-wise and category-wise vacancies furnished by the Regional Rural Banks **subject to availability**. Provisionally allotted candidates are being intimated individually at the email address and mobile number recorded with IBPS at the time of online registration for CWE RRB-IV.

The said provisional allotment has been done based on merit-cum-preference and their reported proficiency in local language* keeping in view the spirit of Govt. Guidelines on reservation policy, various guidelines issued by Govt. of India/Others from time to time, administrative exigency, etc.

In the event of two or more candidates having obtained the same score and same reported language proficiency*, merit order is decided as per date of birth (the candidate senior in age is placed before the candidate junior in age), as per the prevailing practice

Please note:

- (1) No change in the data already registered by the candidate in the online application form is possible.
- (2) The decision of IBPS in allotment of RRBs is final and binding upon the selected candidates. However IBPS reserves the right to cancel, reallocate RRB-wise allocation depending upon exigencies or otherwise.
- (3) The provisional allotment is subject to the candidate fulfilling the criteria for the Regional Rural Bank and identity verification to the satisfaction of the allotted RRB. This does not constitute an offer of employment. In case it is detected at any stage of the recruitment process that, the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria his/her candidature/ chance in the process shall stand forfeited.
- (4) Offer of appointment, terms and conditions, formalities for verification, joining etc. will be issued from the allotted RRB in due course. Decision of the RRB shall be final and binding. The recruitment process/ appointment is solely the purview of the RRBs and shall be final and binding. IBPS has no role here.
- (5) If the candidate does not avail the offer/ appointment from the allotted RRB his/her candidature/ chance in the process shall stand forfeited.

- (6) A list of candidates (post-wise in Registration Number order) provisionally allotted on the basis of marks and reported language proficiency* will be displayed on our website on or before 31.01.2017. However this does not guarantee offer of employment. Decision of the RRBs shall be final.
- (7) The entire provisional allotment process under CWE RRB-IV stands completed with this notification.
- (8) No correspondence will be entertained from the candidate about allotment status and/ process.
- (9) Provisional allotment however is subject to Court order, if any.

* Proficiency in Local Language is a criteria only for the posts of Office Assistants and Officers Scale I.
